Initial Site Appraisal

- Assessment of overgrown and unattended areas of site.
- Removal of weeds from low maintenance areas, pathways and roadways.
- Use of environmentally friendly pesticides to suppress future weed growth.
- Cut back overhanging trees causing obstruction in parking areas.
- Pruned and shaped containerised shrubs.
- Removed debris and dead plants.
- Created edging for lawns and borders.

Ongoing Site Maintenance

- Cutting lawns on every visit to maintain tidy, striped appearance.
- Clearance and disposal of leaf litter.
- Strimming and edging of lawns where necessary.
- Keeping shrubs, trees and hedges in a uniformly tidy state.
- Litter picking on every site visit.
- Keeping all beds and borders weed free and dug over.
- Weed killing on pathways and roads.
- Weekly visits and monthly visits during growing season.
- Work conducted in an environmentally friendly fashion.
- Consideration always taken towards the overall presentation of the site for the enjoyment of the residents.
- Recommendation reports highlighting replacement / additional plants or bark mulch for borders when required.
